



FOR MUCH OF ITS ROUTE this trail--the Wessex Ridgeway--kept to the ridges of hills, but at one point the Ridgeway came down to cross Dorset's River Stour before climbing into hills again.


THE PLACE WHERE the road crossed the river "was once a busy centre on the most important road in the Kingdom". Evidence of struggles to control this crossing is still carved into the land. Ramparts of Iron Age hill forts "more important than any others in Wessex" loom over the valley. Three rings of ditch and bank defences etch the crowns of chalk hills. Trails off the Wessex Ridgeway connect them all.
