**Step 2:** Chain 2 and make 6 single crochet stitches into the magic circle. Pull the yarn tail to tighten the circle.

**Step 3:** Join the round with a slip stitch to the first single crochet stitch.

**Step 4:** Chain 2 and make 2 single crochet stitches into each stitch around. Join with a slip stitch.

**Step 5:** Chain 2 and make 1 single crochet stitch into the first stitch, followed by 2 single crochet stitches into the next stitch. Repeat this pattern around. Join with a slip stitch.

**Step 6:** Continue this pattern, increasing the number of single crochet stitches between increases until you have the desired size for the sole of the slipper.

**Step 7:** Once the sole is complete, begin working on the sides of the slipper. Make single crochet stitches around the edges of the sole, working in continuous rounds until the slipper reaches the desired height.

**Step 8:** To add the bunny ears, join the yarn at the back of the slipper. Make 1 single crochet stitch into the same stitch, followed by 1 half-double crochet stitch and 1 double crochet stitch into the next stitch. Repeat this

pattern once more to create the second ear. Fasten off and weave in any loose ends.

**Step 9:** Finally, add the lacy sock trim to the top of the slipper by making a row of double crochet stitches worked into the front loops only. You can also add a decorative button or ribbon to enhance the overall look.

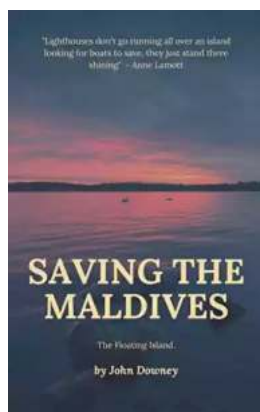
