

# JOHN WYCLIFFE

Born on a Yorkshire sheep farm, John Wycliffe rose to become a towering figure in church history: 'the morning star of the reformation' that changed Western Christianity forever.

- 1320: Born in Trimsted, Yorkshire, England.
- 1324: Attended Oxford University.
- 1327: Master of Balliol College, Oxford.
- 1329: Published *DETERMINATIO QUORUNDAM DE QUESTIONIBUS*, which supported the actions of the English Parliament in refusing the tribute of Pope Urban V.
- 1330: Received doctorate of theology (suspended due to attacks of John's vulgar parables).
- 1332: Appointed rector of Lutterworth parish, Leicestershire, by King Edward III.
- 1334: Summoned to appear before Archbishop Sudbury to answer charges relating to his attacks on the doctrinal system of the church. In May Pope Gregory XI issued five buls (decrees) against Wycliffe, condemning him on 15 separate charges relating to his writing.
- 1336: Placed under house arrest for his views about the church establishment.
- 1380: Completed his English translation of the Bible.
- 1384: Suffered a stroke while conducting mass in his parish church at Lutterworth; died on 31 December.
- 1410: His followers, the Lollards, produced 'The Twelve Conclusions of the Lollards'.
- Wycliffe suffered ultimate indignity of 'posthumous execution'.

## Biography


A philosopher, lay preacher and translator, John Wycliffe's contribution to church history can be regarded as momentous, the theories he initiated sowing the seeds of the Protestant Reformation.




Wycliffe studied theology at Oxford University, developing theories about church reform. He denied priests needed to come between worshippers and God, and also challenged the celibacy of the priesthood, transubstantiation, exorcism, the hallowing of sacramental objects, and indulgences. His controversial sermons struck a chord, but did not sit so well with Rome.




The Bible was written in Latin, but Wycliffe believed God's word should be universally available. Together with a friend, John Purvey, he began translating scripture into the vernacular, stating: "Englishmen love Christ's law best in English. Moses heard God's law in his own tongue; so did Christ's apostles."



Advocating reform until his final days, he died from a stroke in 1384, aged about 64. Over 50 years after his death, Pope Martin V ordered his posthumous execution for heresy. His body was exhumed and burned, the ashes scattered into the River Swift.



His followers, the Lollards, remained a thorn in the side of England's Catholic authorities, eventually publishing 'The Twelve Conclusions of the Lollards' in 1386, presenting it to Parliament and proudly nailing it to the doors of St Paul's Cathedral.



Wycliffe's teachings profoundly influenced Czech theologian Jan Hus. Burnt at the stake for heresy, his followers (Hussites) rebelled against the church, defeating five papal crusades against them from 1420-1431 (The Hussite Wars). Other reformers, such as Martin Luther (1483-1546) and John Calvin (1509-1564), were to continue carrying the torch first kindled by Wycliffe. By the 18th century, the theories originally proposed by the man from Yorkshire were not dissimilar, they were the norm, and the Christian church was altered forever.
