system must be reformed, and that better provision must be made for the higher education of the Catholics of Ireland.

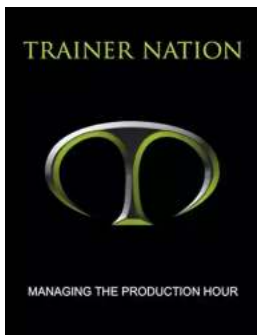

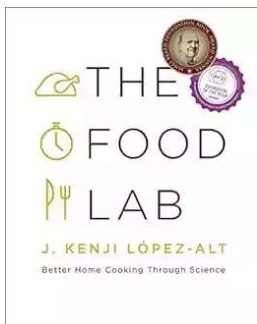
